

Rock salt is a mixture of <u>DANS</u> and <u>TALS</u>. Salt is <u>BULLOSE</u> in water; sand will not <u>VOLSLISED</u> in water.

The <u>CRACKLOTS</u> is stirred with <u>RETAW</u> so the salt goes into <u>SUNILOOT</u> and the sand remains as a <u>SIPSUNOSEN</u>. The murky <u>MUXITER</u> is separated by <u>GRILFEINT</u>, the sand remains as a <u>EDURISE</u> in the <u>FLITER PREAP</u> while the salt solution passes through.

The liquid is <u>DAWMER</u> in an <u>GRAVOTAPRINE</u> basin so the water <u>SEPAROTAVE</u> and white CRASSYLT of RUPE sodium chloride are left in the HIDS.
